We were able to pick up and immediately take Ducky to receive urgent medical care. Because she had been malnourished for quite some time, her legs weren't strong enough to properly support her very tiny body. She also had frostbite on both ears. We slowly restarted her on a proper diet, and she progressed well over the course of a week.

We then noticed she seemed to have taken a turn for the worse. She had become septic with a virus that was attacking her immune system. We were told most shelters would make the decision to euthanize her. However, recognizing she had an incredible drive to fight her illness, we made the decision not to give up on her! After a few nights under 24 hour medical care at our local animal hospital, she was released back to our care. She then began to finally come out of her "shell" and act like a puppy! It started with a few seconds of tug of war and now we are happy to report she is awaiting her spay appointment and she will soon be off to her forever home.



Dear HumaneCNY Members:


