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It's time for the 2026

Annual Membership Drive!

For 60 years, HumaneCNY has been dedicated to caring for Central New York's most vulnerable animals— providing essential medical treatment, compassionate shelter, spay/neuter services, and vaccinations before helping them find loving, permanent homes. **Every animal who comes through our doors receives a second chance thanks to the compassion and support of generous members like you.**

In 2025, we experienced a record-breaking year for both dog and cat intake and adoptions. We took in 862 animals and found loving homes for 808 – more than in any of the past five years. Since 2021, intake has increased by 36% and adoptions have risen by 43%! Each of these increases represents a life saved, a family completed, and a future rewritten.

But a record year is about more than successful adoptions — it also reflects a growing and urgent need. **More than 90% of the dogs and cats who arrive at our shelter come without basic medical care** like being spayed/neutered, vaccinated, and microchipped.

Last year we provided approximately **2,000 vaccinations and 800 microchips** and coordinated and funded over **700 spay/neuter surgeries**. This comprehensive care is included as part of every adoption, helping ensure each animal is healthy and ready for its new home. These are essential services that prevent future suffering and pet overpopulation while giving every animal the best possible chance at a healthy life.

At the same time, shelters across Central New York are facing the same pressures. As intake numbers rise, collaboration between rescues has become more critical than ever. When large-scale situations occur, such as homes with dozens of animals, no single rescue organization can manage the need alone.

Recently, cases like Bluey and Bingo, two of eight dogs removed from a single home, and Priscilla and Paul, FIV+ cats rescued from a hoarding situation, highlight this reality. In both instances, we worked alongside other local organizations to bring these animals into our care. As space and resources are limited for all rescues, these **partnerships ensure that more animals receive the care they urgently need.**

A record year also means our shelter operates at full capacity nearly 12 months a year. Our kennels are full, our staff is constantly in motion, and our resources are stretched further than ever before. Yet, we continue to say “yes” whenever we can.

Your membership makes this lifesaving work possible. With your annual membership support, HumaneCNY will continue to provide critical care, strengthen partnerships with other rescues, and ensure that every animal who enters our shelter is given the opportunity to transition into a safe, healthy, and loving home!

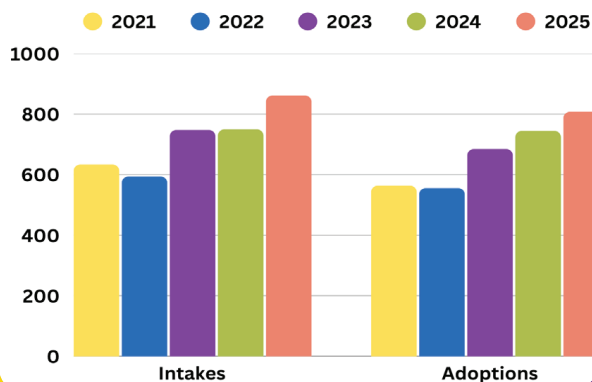
