President's Message

Because CNY's homeless animals deserve more... HumaneCNY manages COVID-19 challenges



Thank you to our community for always standing with us and supporting homeless animals at HumaneCNY. It's because of you that, even during a pandemic, we cared for over 600 animals in 2020.

HumaneCNY continues to be a vital cornerstone within CNY's animal rescue community. We pride ourselves as being local people helping local animals and

as we had hoped, the loving support we offer to dogs, cats, and other small pets has greatly expanded since completing a major shelter renovation in 2019.

Our new facility has truly fulfilled its potential of providing a secure, healthy place for animals to live while they wait for their forever homes. Visitors often compliment our staff on how lovely the shelter is, some saying it's the nicest shelter they've ever visited! In addition to private kennels, community dog rooms, and outside play yards, we plan to add more safety fencing and to fence in a new area for obedience training and agility activities. Our cats now have two free-roam areas, a kitten room, and two rooms for cats with medical conditions or who prefer to live alone. We also plan to purchase new Intake and Isolation Room cat housing as funds become available.

In addition, our staff and volunteers make our shelter a friendly, welcoming setting. Staff arrive early each day to care for the animals, often helped by dedicated volunteers who clean and do laundry. The dogs are walked twice daily, receive frozen Kong treats, and enjoy taking trips to dog parks and ice cream stands. The cats love being petted, playing with toys, and viewing nature from many perches.

We have also increased our collaboration with other rescues. In addition to hundreds of animals brought to us, 43 animals were transferred to us from other groups in 2020. We also transferred out 7 animals to breed-specific and exotic pet rescues. These strong alliances with other rescues allow more animals to receive specialized care and success in quickly finding their forever homes.

HumaneCNY's continued role in CNY rescue is fully dependent upon our volunteers, sponsors, and donors. The time volunteers spend cleaning, donation processing, transporting animals, and promoting the shelter, allows our

staff to focus on dog obedience and cat behavior training, administering medical treatments, scheduling vet visits, interviewing adopters, and making the important decision to place each animal into the best possible home. COVID-19's impact has been softened due to the generosity of local businesses and clubs, along with the steady financial support of our members, especially during our year-end Staffworks' Matching Gift campaign.

So on behalf of our staff and board of directors, I extend a heartfelt thank you to our generous supporters. You are the unseen heroes of this organization. I hope that we are able to invite more visitors into our shelter as pandemic restrictions ease and that all of you have a safe, healthy 2021.

Thank you for believing CNY's animals deserve more!
